Jarocin by Tomaszewski:

Each participant must have his/her own, very well known camera, a laptop computer, an external hard drive, card readers, several memory cards, several batteries. The computer must have two programs installed: Photoshop CS6 and Lightroom - can be demo versions, installed 30 days prior to the workshop.

Silesia by Gola :

Participants are asked for being equipped with photographic equipment (camera, lenses, accessories), laptop and card reader. The laptop should have any program installed, which allow to the simplest processing of photos (cropping, dodging and burning, making a contrast, compressing images to jpg format). The participants from abroad are asked to have the pocket glossary of the basic phrases in Polish.
